

Maitland Levee – Horseshoe Bend Repair Works

The Department of Planning and Environment are continuing repair works as part of the Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme

As part of the Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme, the Department completed stage 1 emergency repair works at Horseshoe Bend to stabilise the Maitland Levee in January 2023.

Stage 2 will begin in November and will take approximately six months to complete. This is our final phase of work to complete the levee restoration.

The Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme is designed to mitigate flood risk as an integrated system operating across multiple local government areas, covering urban, peri-urban and rural areas.

Our work schedule

We will begin establishing our work area from **Monday 6 November**, these works will include fencing, installing site sheds and signage.

Construction work to repair the levee will begin from **Monday 20 November**, these works will include excavating, earthworks and rock delivery and installation.

Our work hours will be between **7 am** and **6 pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and **8 am** and **1 pm** on **Saturdays**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including reducing the speed limit for construction vehicles on Carrington St and Matthew Lane to **20 km/h**.

Traffic changes

There may be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

Trucks will enter our work zone via Carrington Street and Mathews Lane.
