

## Maitland Levee – Horseshoe Bend Repair Works

# The Department of Planning and Environment are continuing repair works as part of the Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme

As part of the Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme, the Department is working on Stage 2 of the levee restoration at Horseshoe Bend. Stage 1 emergency repair works were completed in January 2023.

The Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme is designed to mitigate flood risk as an integrated system operating across multiple local government areas, covering urban, peri-urban and rural areas.

Work is progressing on the levee. So far, we have established the site and have been importing and placing additional rock along the levee

#### Our work schedule

We are taking a break over the holiday period and will finish work on Friday 22 December, returning on Monday 8 January 2024. We will continue earth works and rock placement on the levee in the new year.

Our work hours will be between 7 am and 6 pm from Monday to Friday and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturdays.

#### How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including reducing the speed limit for construction vehicles on Carrington St to **20km/h** and Matthew Lane to **5 km/h**.


#### **Traffic changes**
