The Dubbo Workplace Hub will deliver a multi-million-dollar regional workplace hub, through the redevelopment of existing government-owned buildings at Carrington Avenue and Brisbane Street, Dubbo.

Subject to planning approval, the Dubbo Workplace Hub will consolidate existing government offices spread across the town into a modern, efficient building, providing a quality workplace for hundreds of regional public servants consistent with the high standards of metro locations.

The Dubbo Workplace Hub will join a successful network of Whole-of-Government regional hubs which currently includes Gosford, Orange and Newcastle, as well as a future new hub in Coffs Harbour.

Modern, consolidated workplace hubs help the government attract and support people living and working in the regions, resulting in better connections with communities and improved service delivery.

Project Information:

- The revitalised building will meet or exceed the government's rating targets, such as NABERS and Greenstar.
- By re-developing the existing building rather than undertaking a full demolition and rebuild process, the proposed hub reduces resource consumption, energy use and emissions.
