I acknowledge the extensive work done by the DPIE in relation to the Far North Coast Water Strategy.

However, that plan should not rely too heavily on Rous Water's plan for the contentious Dunoon Dam. I oppose the inclusion of the Dunoon Dam in the FNC Water Strategy.

The Dunoon Dam will leave the FNC vulnerable to climate change, will not provide water security, will destroy a significant Aboriginal heritage site, remove an important koala corridor and put further pressure on other endangered species, including platypus and native fish.
