

# Floodplain harvesting measurement in practice

The Floodplain Harvesting Measurement Policy's guiding principles are that measurement is:



Accurate



Auditable



Tamper proof

## What has the NSW Government already done?

NSW Government released the Floodplain Harvesting Measurement Policy in 2020. It is a blue print for measuring and monitoring floodplain harvesting.

## What is the NSW Government doing?

NSW has made significant progress implementing the Measurement Policy, including:

- establishing, with Irrigation Australia Limited, a specific qualification for installers of floodplain harvesting measurement equipment
- establishing a facility to test floodplain harvesting measurement devices and publishing a list of suitable floodplain harvesting measurement devices
- upgrading its existing telemetry system to receive data from floodplain harvesting measurement devices.

## What happens next?

Amendments to the Water Management (General) Regulation 2018 are required to ensure that the Floodplain Harvesting Measurement Policy is legally enforceable.
