Subject: Dunoon Dam. Part of Rous's Future Water 2060 project.

I am a resident of Dunoon and I think that the idea of a Dam placed on Rocky Creek just 700 metres upstream of The Channon village is an absolute disaster. This area is a unique rainforest that is growing on sandstone. The flora and fauna have a right to their environment and the cultural heritage of the Widgibal aboriginal people must be preserved.

This dam has no social license. 91% of the nearly 1300 submissions to the RCC were opposed to the Dam. The people in the area do not want to see the industrialisation of this unique area. Only 1% of what was known as The Big Scrub is left. This dam will decimate more of it.

RCC has failed to acknowledge innovative water management. All options need to taken into account including roof and storm water harvesting, purified recycled water and desalination operated with renewables. If we are worried about lack of rain why are RCC relying on a dam which needs rain to add to our supply.

Hoping that the department will take into account these arguments when considering the Rous County Council, Future Water Project 2060. in 2020.
