Hi, I have been a northern rivers resident all of my life. I have seen the population grow to more than three times over the past 40 years and have also seen a corresponding decline in our wildlife and natural beauty of this area.

I am glad that you are looking into the sustainability of our water supply but kindly ask that you please do not include the proposed Dunoon Dam as part of any water strategy.

Koalas and platypus and lots of other species will decline if the dam goes ahead. Destruction of remnant rainforest will also lead to the deaths of fruit bats and native frogs - many of which are listed as threatened species. If a dam goes ahead then there will not be any going back.
