To whom this may concern,

Water security is of course important, which is why it's important to get it right when choosing our strategy.

A mega dam between The Channon and Dunoon, on sandstone (for a wonder!), destroying highly endangered rainforest habitat, wildlife corridors and Aboriginal heritage is NOT the best strategy to ensure our water security.

We have a dam, with a pumping station that tops it up. With this, water efficiency measures, and broad scale investment in water tanks local populations can achieve water security. The growing coastal populations can pay for water security that is not solely reliant on rainfall.

We need to listen to the modern experts in the field and ensure we build water resilience into our water systems.

All options need to be given serious attention including water efficiency, roof and stormwater harvesting (including tanks), and water sources that don't need rain such as purified recycled water and desalination.
